

Things to Learn in College

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I. Introduction. There are three things one needs to get in college: knowledge about how to walk with God, training and an ability to make disciples.

II. How to walk with God.

A. College is the best opportunity to learn to walk with God.

B. One needs to exercise the disciplines in order to walk like Jesus.

C. There is a difference between legalism and discipline. Discipline acknowledges that favor has already been given and cannot be earned. (Romans 15:4, I Corinthians 10:11, Mark 1:35, Luke 6:12, Matthew 14:23, Luke 5:16)

D. You should not be primarily concerned with your career. Wherever you work, you are an insider for Christ.

III. Training.

A. Memorize Scripture.

1. God will use Scripture that you memorize.

2. You will not be perfect with Scripture memory, but be persistent.

B. Learn to turn your mind to God daily.

C. Listen to sermons, such as those posted at discipleshiplibrary.org.

D. Now is the greatest time to learn to walk with God.

IV. Make disciples. (Matthew 28:16-20)

A. Jesus commissioned eleven to make disciples over every people group.

B. The demand could only be met through spiritual multiplication.
