- We need to understand our uniqueness, but the key is our availability (2 Corinthians 5:19, 20; Hebrews 11; 2 Timothy 1:9, 14)

Our <u>Mission</u> is to Love God and Love People

Our <u>Vision</u> is to start with the People around Us

- It is not limited to a building or an organization but an ever-expanding circle of influence. Integration simplifies our lives. The longer the time, the larger the influence.
- We must see where God is working and join Him there. (Blackaby) (Deuteronomy 6:6, 7; Acts 1:8, Mark 16:15; John 17: 15, 18)

Our <u>Ministry</u> is to Serve People with diversity

- By dying to self, we express Christ's love to others by making eternal investments in their lives. We do this by our attitudes, our words, and our actions in concert with other believers as we serve together using various gifts.
- Our #1 problem is patience, but by being both intentional and spontaneous, we can be both caring, encouraging, loving and allowing the Holy Spirit to work!
- After establishing their trust, we walk through the open doors of opportunity. (Matthew 20:26-28; Romans 12)
